Stuttering Treatment Plan Exercise

You have completed an assessment for Juan, a 25 year old software engineer who has stuttered since he was three years old. During your evaluation, he produced many part-word repetitions and prolongations on words beginning with labial phonemes. Write a treatment plan for Juan using the Camperdown Program. Be sure to include elements such as the 9-point SR and NAT scales and prolonged speech.

- 1. Prognostic statement (amount of progress expected and time frame in which progress can be anticipated)
- 2. Long-term goal (statement about general area of intervention needed)
- 3. Short-term objectives (to be worked on immediately)
 - a. Achievable in four weeks or less
 - b. Part of hierarchical progression of objectives based on task analysis
 - c. Written in measurable terms
 - d. Include conditions under which targeted behavior will occur
 - e. Include criteria for progressing to next objective or discontinuation of therapy
- 4. Procedures and materials
 - a. Include techniques to elicit targeted behaviors
 - b. Include type of feedback and reinforcement to be provided
