Last day to drop course in order to receive 100% refund/
credit for **Nursing Students**
Full-Term courses May 26, 2008

First Half-Term courses May 19, 2008
Second Half-Term courses July 11, 2008

Courses beginning on dates other than those listed, as listed
in the Schedule of Classes available on LoboWeb, are fully
refundable if dropped before 20% of the course has been com-
pleted, except for Correspondence Courses (see paragraph
below). Do not include partial days when calculating 20% of
completion. For example, 20% of an eight day course equals
1.6 days. Refund is calculated only if dropped on or before the
first day.

Courses five days or less in duration must be dropped on or
before the first day of the course to receive a full refund.

Correspondence Courses are fully refundable if dropped
before 9% of the course has been completed. Do not include
partial days when calculating 9% of completion.

Tuition and fees for courses dropped after the above deadlines
will not be refunded.
